

Sub: - Extension of time limit for direct conversion/issue of permit against Foreign Flight Radio Telephone Operators Licence (FRTOL) issued by commonwealth countries and Philippines.

Vide this Ministry's notifications of even numbers issued in, June, 2009 and September, 2009 validity of the permit issued against Foreign FRTOL was extended up to 31/12/2009 for the Pilot and Aircraft Maintenance Engineers (AMEs) respectively. Representations have been received from some Airline operators for extending the validity beyond 31/12/2009. The case has been examined by this Ministry and it has been decided to extend the validity of the permit issued to Pilot and AMEs upto 31/01/2010.

2. The extension up to 31/01/2010 is hereby granted as a special dispensation to Aircraft Maintenance Engineers and pilots so as to enable them to complete the formalities in the on-going examination. No further extension beyond 31/01/2010 shall be considered unless qualified in the examination as per existing rules.

3. All concerned are requested to send their application along with the relevant fees to the Ministry to bring this extension into effect in their certificates.
